New Migration Agents registering after 1 September 2011:

Those applying to be a migration agent after 1 September 2011 will need to do a special Practice Ready Program (not offered by us) in the first year of practice. This leaves you with 2 points to get elsewhere and as a special to new migrations agents we can offer you the 2 CPD points for \$99 (incl GST) in order to meet your 10 CPD point first year registration requirements.
